

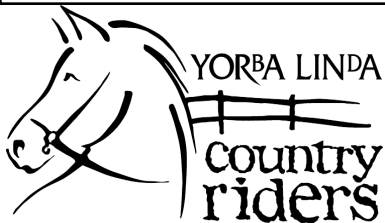

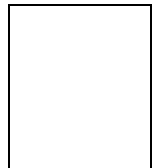

WINTER CARE FOR YOUR HORSE

Winter care and management for your horse during the winter is essential. The cold temperature, the horses requirements for energy, shelter and hoof care becomes more demanding.

As temperatures become colder, you may ride less and become less engaged in a horse's daily care since they are not being ridden as often. Club President Dee Dee Friedrich uses this analogy, *"You can park a boat in the garage and get it out 6 months later, that doesn't work with the horses, we always explain it a 'LIFESTYLE' NOT a Hobby."*



Low temperatures, wind and wet conditions will increase the demand on the horse's body for heat production. The critical lower temperature for horses are between 30 and 50 degrees Fahrenheit, depending on hair coat, body condition, wetness and wind chill.

YLCR Newsletter Layout Calvin Louie will blanket his horse with the temperature below 30 degree Fahrenheit or when heavy rain or snow is predicted. Obtaining current weather forecasts is what a responsible horse owner does. Calvin works and competes with his horse year round.



It is recommended that a wet horse should not be blanketed. Increasing their feed can help to maintain their weight and body condition on a forage diet with access to a salt block

Heavy coat and shelter is the horse's first defense to coldness. These snow pictures were taken at Calvin's home stables and arena on Monday morning on January 27.

Hoof care must be kept on schedule at all times. At times, picking out the horse's hooves may prevent expensive visits to the veterinarian and farrier. Packed mud, ice, or snow can not only cause hoof issues, but could result in lameness because of an unbalance hoof.

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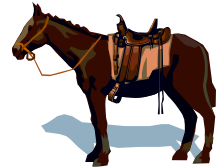

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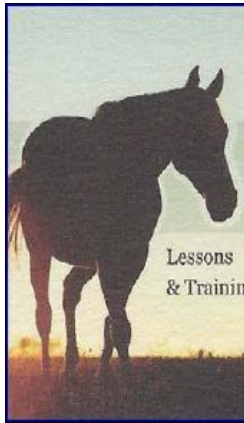
