



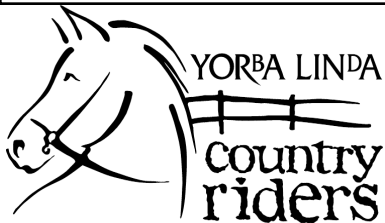

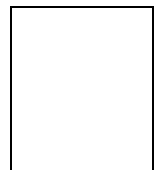

Hoof Beats by the Club President

I'm going to address a significant portion of this President's letter to update you on a very important issue for all horse owners, Large Animal Evacuation. While there are lots of wheels spinning the bottom line is currently nothing has changed since our own disastrous Yorba Linda Freeway Complex Fire of 2008. So, for now every horse owner should develop a personal "PLAN," meaning if you do not own a horse trailer, you should have someone, and a backup person, lined up to help you during an emergency. If you go on vacation double check your resources before you leave town. If you are not aware the old LART rescue team of San Juan is out of business for any cities other than San Juan, so again, establish a plan.

Now for some encouraging news. Yorba Linda is working on our own smaller, temporary plan thanks to City employee, Disaster Coordinator, Chris Pena. We have a small group from YLCR that continues to meet with Chris, and hopefully this small-scale plan will be ready to go into effect soon. Next, I have the honor of representing Yorba Linda on another committee that is pressuring Don Wagner, our County Supervisor, to replace the now terminated LART with a County wide plan ASAP. We all know how slow the wheels turn in politics, so this committee is doing our best to move it forward, hopefully before the upcoming fire season. For now, I just can't stress enough the importance of being ready and remember this is not just for fires, but also includes earthquakes or any emergency that could come our way. All of this will be discussed in depth at our General Meeting on May 1st, 2024, see page 2 for meeting details.

I'm hoping we have some interest in a Casper's Day ride for May 19th, see page 2 for the information. If we don't have enough interest in trailering to Casper's, but you'd rather trail ride in Yorba Linda let me know. We would also like to plan a Camping trip so let me know if you have any interest in participating.

Hope to see Y'all at the General Meeting on May 1st. There are still a few of our long-time members that have not yet rejoined for 2024, and we'd like to keep you on our list. I always say this, but the larger our roster, the more they/the City pays attention.

YLCR CONTINUES TO WORK WITH THE CITY OF YORBA LINDA

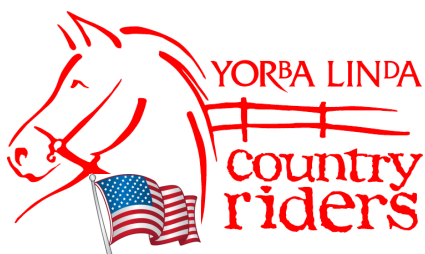
