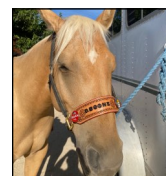
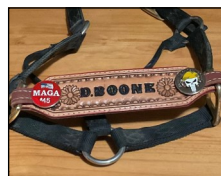


Cyndi Daiello riding at Circle S Ranch for her first time and her horse Ramona did great!! She even had a qualifying run, CONGRATS CYNDI!



LAKOTA WESTERN US CHAMPIONSHIP Cowboy Mounted Shooting Assn.

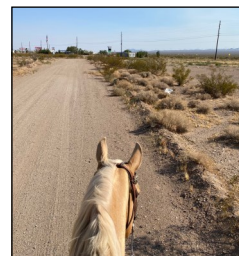

This past Sunday (July 28, 2024), I lost not only a piece of me, but one of the most monumental things to ever come into my life.

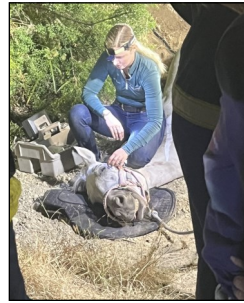


That is you...my first horse.

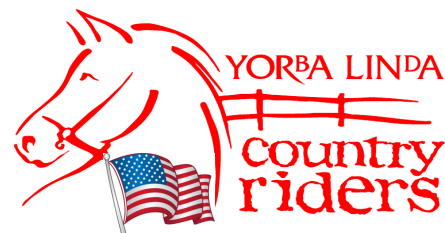

YLCR Club President Dee Dee Friedrich was called to the Yorba Linda lakebed at 7:45pm and we arrived to see Gitana down like the above left picture. I know it doesn't look big or steep but she was kinda stuck in the rut and couldn't get traction to get up.

So we called Orange County Fire Authority (OCFA) and the veterinarian. The veterinarian sedated her so they could safely put their big steel plate under her & then their truck with a huge cable drug her to a flat wash area so when the sedation wore off she could stand up. Happy to say the plan worked perfectly thanks to an AMAZING veterinarian, Dr Keating of Equine Veterinary Hospital, a huge also amazing couple of fire crews and all the YLCR members that came to help when I called. 3-4 hours later, everyone was home safe.

Orange County Animal Control sent 2 Officers that were on the scene first and they worked hard but they just didn't have the resources like the OCFA had. Again, they were very helpful and compassionate.

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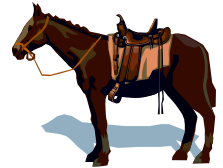

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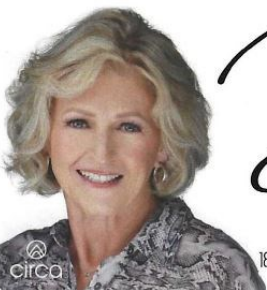
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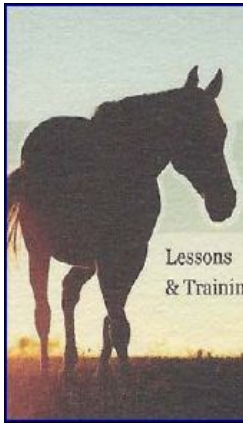
