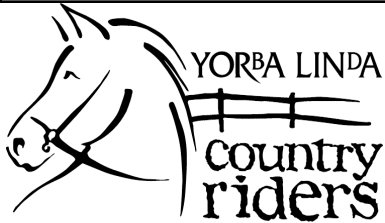

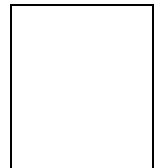

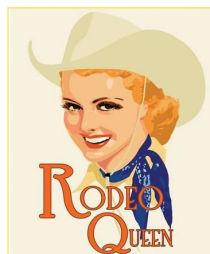


John & Nancy Ferguson mini Tot

TRAILER OUT TO EXPLORE NEW TRAILS Part 2

Loop 3 will around the park to the left on a wide dirt road. At the end of the park by the Butterfly Garden is an open gate and a small trail that leads you to Chino Hills Discovery Center parking lot. To finish the loop, you can go back along the fence line near the creek, or on the park road that is next to Carbon Canyon Road.



I usually walk on the grass next to the road. Of course you can combine any of these loops to make your ride longer. Loops 1 and 3 are fairly flat.

The North Ridge trail has been closed for years so you will be riding on the Telegraph Trail. For the longer loop, take the Telegraph Trail to the Little Canyon Trail (about 4 miles), then coming back on the South Ridge Trail, connecting to the Telegraph Trail by turning right on the Diemer Trail. This loop is approximately 8-9 miles total. Be careful not to turn on the East Street Trail as it is for hikers only being narrow and steep.

I'd also like to share with you about the Irvine Ranch Conservancy. They offer many fun and interesting guided rides through Irvine Ranch. The rides are free although there is a fee to enter Irvine Regional Park where many of the rides are staged. The rides include trails in the Black Star Wilderness, Weir Canyon and Red Rock Wilderness. The rides usually require a reservation as space is limited. There is a schedule online at: letsgoutise.org

Whichever park you choose, you will have an enjoyable, interesting ride. So go out and have fun.

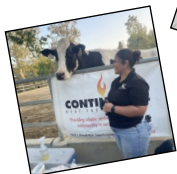

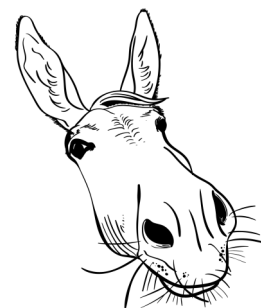
