



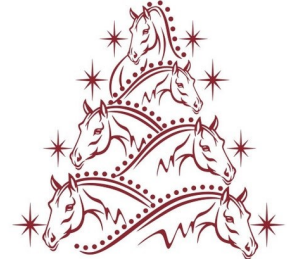

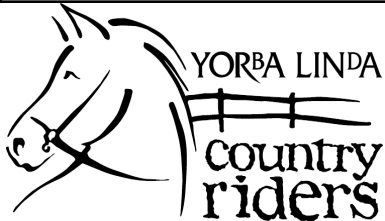

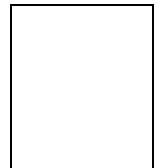

Airport Fire, New Mini Cow Named Liberty, Tehachapi Mt. Rodeo

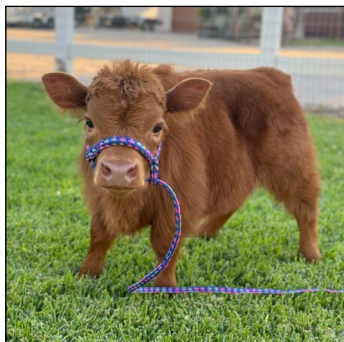


The Airport Fire broke out on the afternoon of Sept. 9, 2024. Many Yorba Lindans took off to Trabuco Canyon to help with horse evacuations. Between horse owners and volunteers over 150 horses were moved to safer locations. We were released about 9 PM once they felt the horses were either evacuated or safe.



Unfortunately the fires shifted on Tuesday the 10th and we were sent out again. This time it was Silverado Canyon and once again, over 150 horses were moved to safety. Luckily on the Orange County side there were no loss of life, animals or homes but sadly it went over the hill into the Lake Elsinore area and they did lose some homes.

A BIG THANK YOU goes out to everyone that put their day aside and helped horses and equestrians in need. I will have a big update on the County Large Animal Evacuation Team at our upcoming meeting at the November 6, 2024 general meeting.
