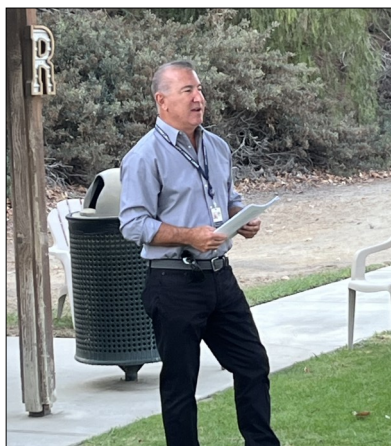
Victoria Suero Kornoff was a YLCR member her entire childhood.

We changed up our meeting location & met at Phillip S. Paxton Equestrian Center, located at 18661 Buena Vista Avenue, Yorba Linda, CA 92887.

It was a nice atmosphere with Pony Club lessons in the arena.

Chris shared the latest updates to our Yorba Linda large animal evacuation plans such as how we will use Paxton arena as a temporary staging area to get all the horses off the hills or any areas where horses are in danger. Once we get all animals safe we will follow instructions if needed, to seek longer term boarding and care until it is safe to return the horses home.

Meet her new pigs Waffles & Maple Syrup & the goats are Bagel & Sourdough.



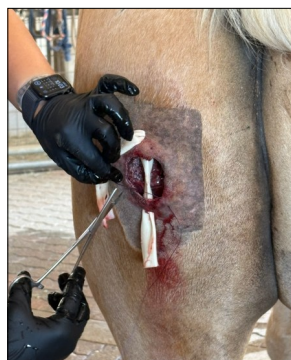

Cellulitis Affects YLCR Daniel Boone



Equine Cellulitis is a serious bacterial infection affecting the soft tissues under a horse's skin, most commonly observed in the hind limbs. It can lead to severe swelling, pain, and potential complications if not addressed promptly.

It begins with swelling in the affect area.

- **Significant Swelling:** Affected limbs often exhibit dramatic swelling, sometimes giving a "stovepipe" appearance.
- **Heat and Pain:** The limb feels hot and is painful to the touch. Horses may be unwilling to bear weight on the affected leg.
- **Fever:** Many horses with cellulitis will have a noticeably high temperature.
- **Rapid Onset:** Symptoms can develop suddenly and can escalate quickly.

Daniel Boone was immediately transport to Dr. Alana Layton, DVM, Acton, CA .

Prompt veterinary intervention is crucial. Treatment options may include:

- **Antibiotics:** To combat the bacterial infection.
- **Anti-inflammatory Medications:** To reduce swelling and pain.
- **Supportive Care:** This includes rest, potentially hydrotherapy (cold hosing), and controlled movement to help reduce swelling.

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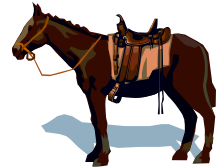
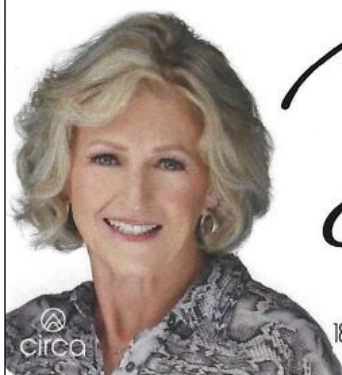

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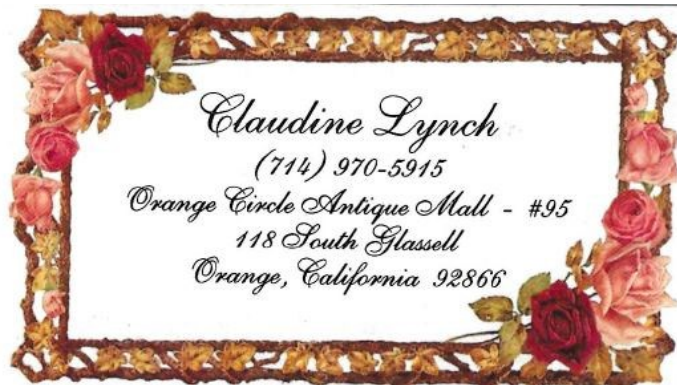
